Milan – Como Lake – Turin – Piedmont Countryside

2 nights in Milan - 2 nights in Turin – 4 nights in Piedmont Countryside



Autumn is upon us and which Italian region should we visit in the autumn months? One of our favorites is undoubtedly Piedmont. This region, located in the north-west, borders with France and Switzerland, with which it shares part of the Alps. Famous for its prestigious wines, truffles, cheeses and enchanting landscapes, Piedmont is a region that will satisfy any type of tourist.



DAY 1

Arrive in Milano and meet your driver at after you exit Baggage Claim. You will be transferred to your hotel in the center of town. Check into your Hotel and enjoy your first day in Italy!

DAY 2

Milan City Tour

After breakfast, enjoy a first taste of Milan, with a private guided walking tour of the city center. Mainly renowned as the Italian fashion & design capital, the city has several masterpieces that are worth a visit: your expert local guides will help you to discover its beauty and to fully appreciate its incredible art, history and culture.

DAY 3

Transfer to Turin. Como Lake Excursion.

Explore the marvelous Lake Como during an half-day guided tour on board a private boat and be left speechless by the beautiful scenery that has enchanted visitors for centuries. You will cruise along the coast on both sides of the Lake, having marvelous views of the small villages and noble historic villas. Before departing the lake, enjoy an authentic Italian lunch. Depart Como Lake in the late afternoon to reach the Turin. Check into your Hotel.

DAY 4

Discovering Turin

After breakfast, enjoy a first taste of Turin, with a private guided walking tour of the city center. Walking through the streets of the center of Turin, you will be enchanted by the noble palaces and the large squares that follow one after the other. During your tour you will taste one of the most famous hazelnuts chocolate: the Gianduiotto!



DAY 5

Discovering the royal residence of Stupinigi

Meet your guide in the hotel lobby and start your journey through the Italian Royal Residence of Stupinigi. It is one of the residences that hosted the royal family of Savoy who reigned in Italy. Let yourself be enchanted by their beauty and richness. At the end of the visit, your driver will take you to the resort located in the countryside and where you will stay for the next four nights.

DAY 6

Piedmont Countryside: not just wine

Meet your guide in the hotel lobby and start your journey through the Langhe hills with a private car service. Piedmont is mainly known as the land of Italy's finest red wines - Barolo and Barbaresco - and delectable food. This part of Italy is largely untouched by tourism and is - in many ways - the true Italy, honest and fiercely proud of its culinary heritage. But the Langhe region is not just about food and wine. Majestic medieval fortresses rise imperiously from the landscape: wonderfully atmospheric on a misty day, many of the castles are home to fascinating collections and most are still in private hands.

DAY 7

Truffle Hunting:

In the early afternoon, meet with your driver in the hotel lobby, who will take you to the truffle's hill. Meet the "trifolao" (truffle hunter in Piedmontese dialect) and his trusty dog. Get on board an off-road vehicle to explore the woods and to easily reach the truffle hunting area. Finish your truffle hunting and enjoy an aperitif on a natural panoramic viewpoint (assortment of snacks and truffle-based products and drinks will be provided). At the end of your aperitivo, your private driver will transfer you to the truffle hunter's house, to experience a special dinner with the "trifolao" and his family.



DAY 8

Wine, wine and...wine!

Enjoy a full-day centered around the most celebrated Italian red wine: Barolo. You will explore the land where Barolo is produced and aged, learning why it is known worldwide as "the wine of the kings, the king of wines". Your private local guide - an extremely knowledgeable wine connoisseur - will lead you through the visits to the some of the most important wineries of the area and emerging new names, meeting the owners and winemakers.

DAY 9

Meet your driver in the hotel lobby. He will take you to Malpensa International Airport, where you'll take the flight back to the United States.
